Notice of Study Commencement and Public Open House

The TTC is pleased to invite you to attend a Public Open House to learn more about the project, speak one-on-one with staff and provide your comments.

Study Overview

The study will ensure convenient public access is maintained to Keelesdale Park and Chris Tonks Arena during tunneling for the Eglinton Crosstown Transit project. The existing entrance to the park from Eglinton will be used by construction vehicles and an assessment of alternate entrances for the public has been undertaken. A new bridge (see map) within the park is recommended to provide access from Black Creek Drive.

The new bridge would provide several benefits:

- separate construction vehicles from the public during tunneling construction
- enhance traffic flow
- provide a lasting link between Chris Tonks Arena and the future York Community Centre and access to both from Eglinton Ave or Black Creek Dr

Process

The study is being undertaken as a Schedule "B" Class EA project in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process. Upon completion a Summary Report will be placed in the public record for a 30-day review period.

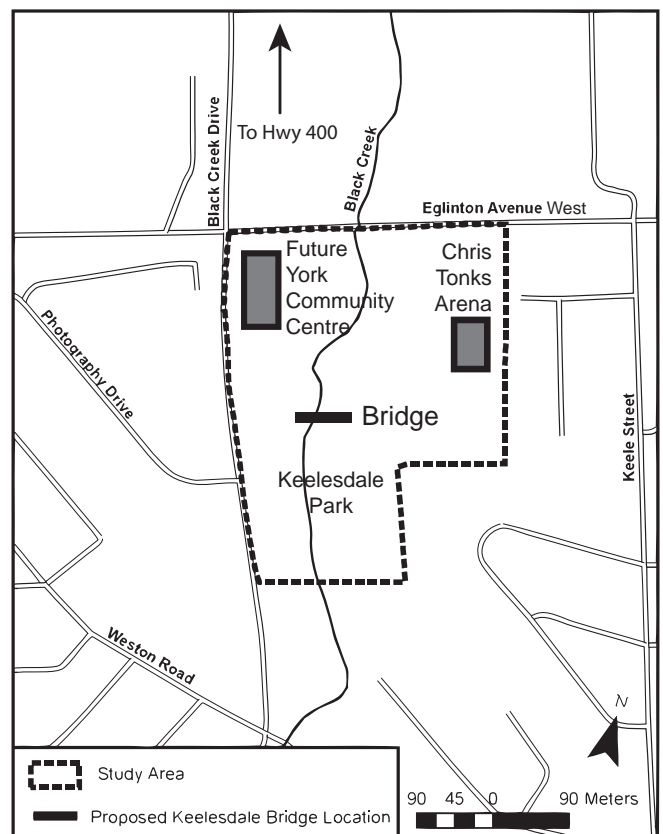
