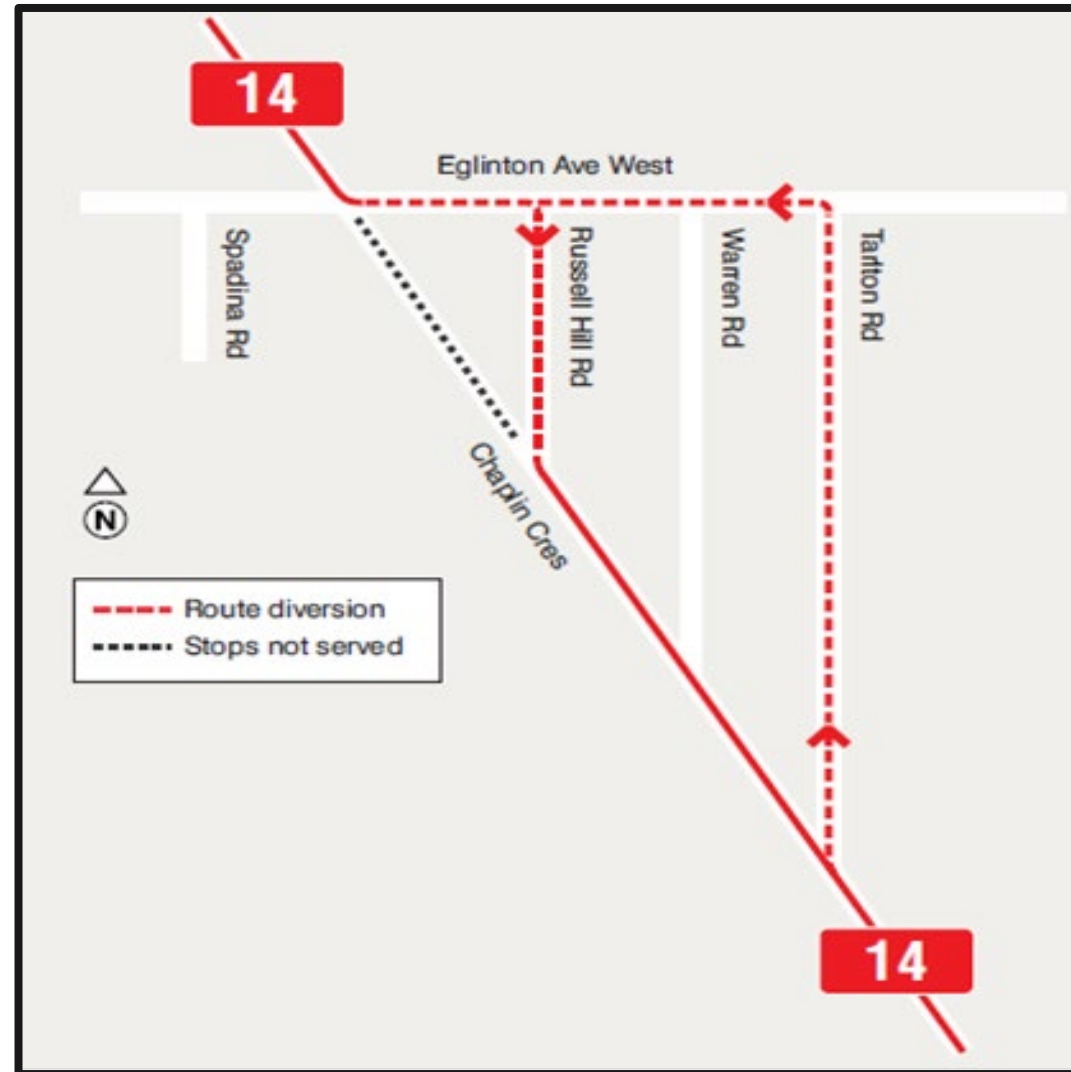

Final lining (waterproofing, rebar installation, and mechanical electrical works)	Throughout all station areas	Underway through early 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deliveries at the main and secondary entrances
Concrete Pours	Between the Main and Secondary Entrances	Three times per week for approx. 12 - 18 hours through 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concrete truck activity • Occupation of the westbound curb lane during some pours
Eglinton Connects Streetscape and Cycle Track	Eglinton Ave between Lascelles Blvd and Duplex Ave	Underway through mid 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eglinton reduced to one lane in each direction between Lascelles Blvd & Duplex Ave • Use of excavator, hydro-vac and concrete trucks

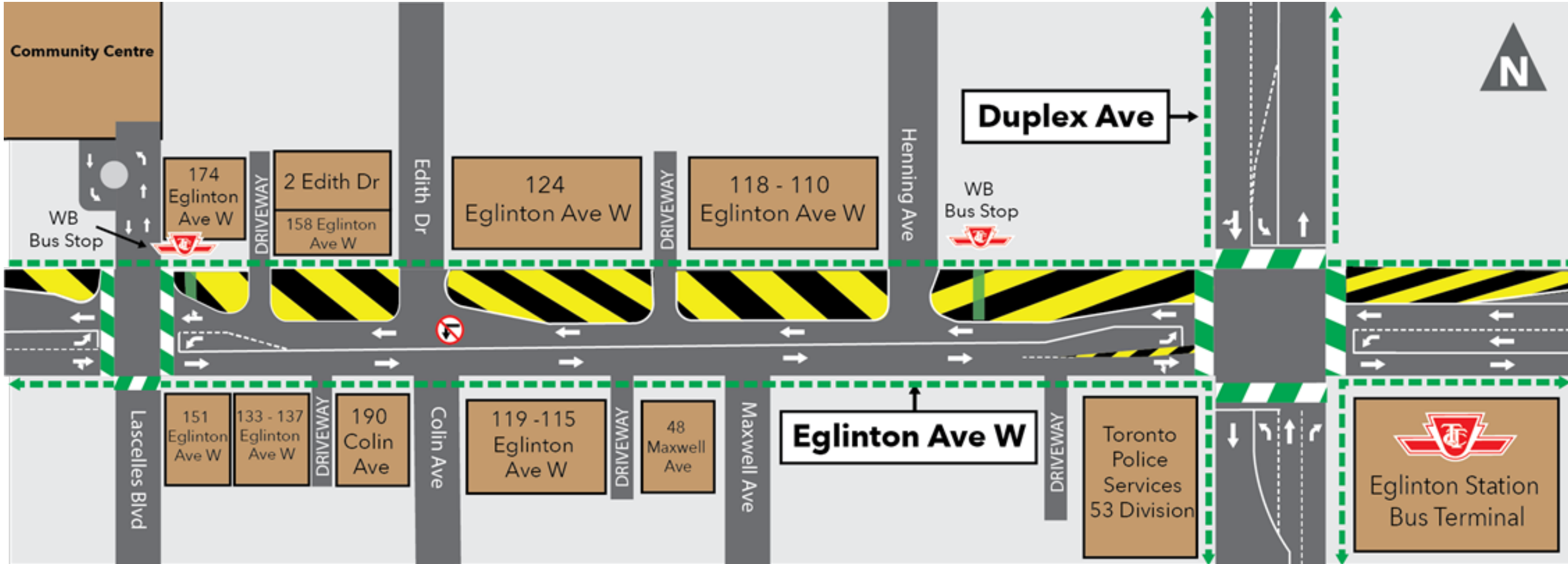

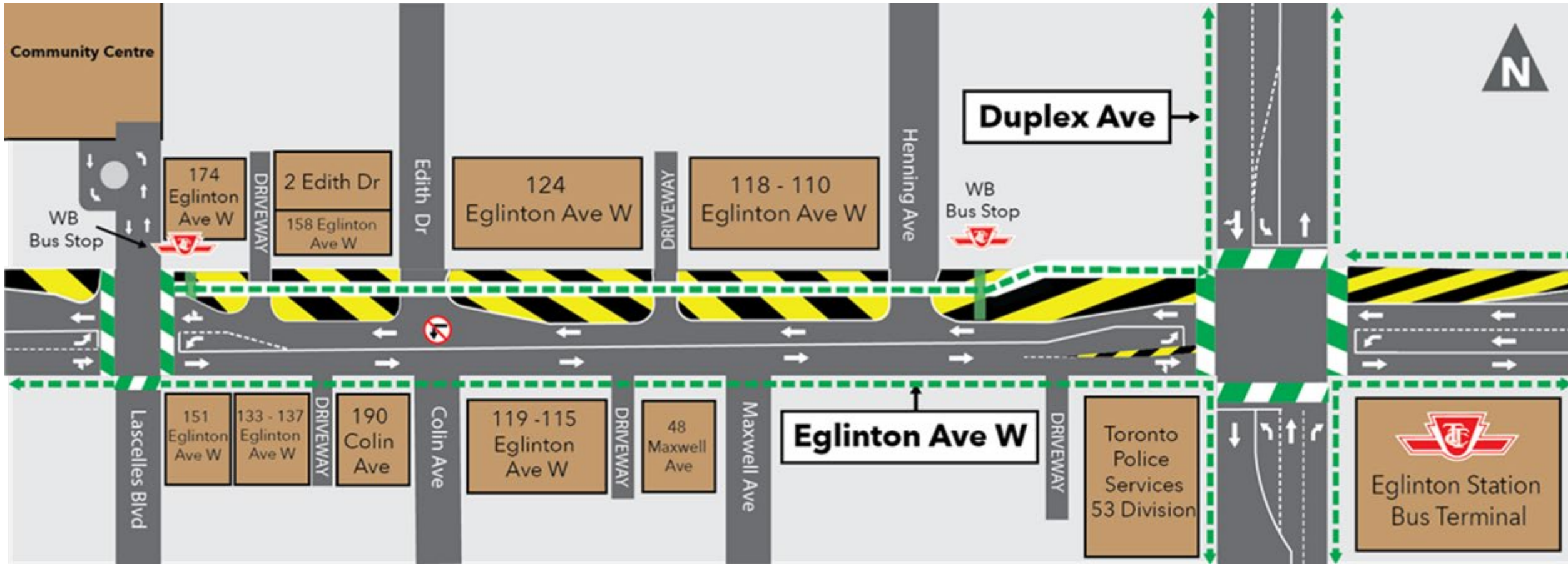
CURRENT TRAFFIC CONFIGURATION: LASCELLES BLVD TO DUPLEX AVE

EGLINTON CONNECTS CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW

Construction of the new Eglinton Streetscape and Cycle Track between Lascelles Blvd and Duplex Ave will continue into 2021.

The Eglinton Connects Streetscape and Cycle Track is being constructed in coordination with the City of Toronto's Streetscape and Cycle Track Design.

Construction Hours:

- Monday - Saturday, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. with periodic overnight work

Construction Activities:

- Excavation
- Utility Reinstatement
- Concrete Work
- Compaction and Paving
- Landscaping - installation of street furnishings, light poles, trees etc.

To accommodate this work, all street furnishings, bus shelters, and trees between Lascelles Blvd and Duplex Ave will be removed. Notice will be provided in advance of removals.

Upon completion of Eglinton Connects, additional street furnishings and trees will be installed/planted along Eglinton Ave.
