Waste Collection Notice During Crosstown Construction

The Eglinton Crosstown is a transit project that will provide rapid and reliable service across Eglinton Avenue. It includes an underground central section from Keele Street to Laird Drive, bring transit service that will be up to 60% faster than bus service today.



Your Waste Collection

The City of Toronto's Solid Waste Management Services division is responsible for collecting, transporting, processing, composting and disposing of municipal and private sector solid waste and recyclables, as well as household hazardous waste.

Solid Waste Management Services will continue to pick up your waste during the construction of the Crosstown. Recycling and garbage collection schedules along Eglinton Avenue will not change during the construction period. Please continue to abide by their guidelines for your garbage disposal and follow your normal routine. Please label your bins with your address and place them as close to the usual location as possible before 7 a.m. or the night before the scheduled collection day. If necessary during construction, your bins may be temporarily moved by the contractor.
